

Brickwork

Welcome to Brickwork at Wiltshire College & University Centre

Please find below details of course related costs and items you may need to get, ready for the start of term.

Resource Fee

You will need to pay your £25 non-refundable Resource Fee before coming to enrol. This can be done on the online shop <u>Wiltshire College Online Shop</u> You will need to bring a copy of your receipt to enrolment as proof of purchase. If you cannot pay online, please pay by card on enrolment day.

Stationery

All students are required to provide their own personal stationery to include pads, pens and pencils, poly pockets and folders ready for the start of term. Level 2 students will need a 10 piece maths set to include ruler, 45% and 60% set squares, 180% protractor, compass, pencil, sharpener, eraser, black and blue pens.

Course tutors will advise of any specific requirements at the start of term.

Equipment

Steel toe capped boots are required and are available to purchase from a number of local workwear and shoe shops at an approximate cost of £20. Please ensure you have these for the first day of term.

Safety gloves and any other PPE will be provided, as required.

Books

Your tutor will advise of any textbooks that are recommended at the start of term. The college has a fully stocked Learning Resource Centre.

Level 1 : The City & Guilds Textbook: Bricklaying for the Level 1 Diploma (6705) (**ISBN**-1398319368) cost is approximately £25

Level 2; The City & Guilds Textbook: Bricklaying for the Level 2 Technical Certificate & Level 3 Advanced Technical Diploma (7905), Level 2 & 3 Diploma (6705) and Level 2 Apprenticeship (9077) (**ISBN-** 151045814X) cost is approximately £30.

We recommend that if your place is conditional in achieving exam results that you do not purchase items until your place is confirmed.

CSCS Cards

Students who have completed and achieved a level 1 Diploma in Bricklaying and are returning to undertake Level 2 will have an opportunity to sit the CSCS HS&E test for

operatives. You will then be able to apply for a CSCS basic skills card. This will support the work experience on your study programme which may lead to progression to an apprenticeship.

The cost of the CSCS test and purchasing the CSCS is approximately £60.00.

Trips

All students will have the opportunity to go on study trips during their course. Your course lecturer will notify you of any additional costs and these should be paid though the Wiltshire College online shop <u>Wiltshire College Online Shop</u>
