

Carpentry and Joinery

Welcome to Carpentry and Joinery at Wiltshire College and University Centre.

Please find below details of course related costs and items you may need to purchase, ready for the start of term.

Resource Fee

You will need to pay your £25 non-refundable Resource Fee before coming to enrol. This can be done on the online shop www.shop.wiltshire.ac.uk You will need to bring a copy of your receipt to enrolment as proof of purchase. If you cannot pay online, please pay by card on enrolment day.

Stationery

All students are required to provide their own pens and pencils for all sessions.

Books

Level 1 - You are required to purchase the City & Guilds text book; Carpentry & Joinery for the Level 1 Diploma (6706) - (**ISBN-10** 1398319376) available at amazon for £25

Level 2 - You are required to purchase the City & Guilds text book; Level 2 Diploma in Site Carpentry & bench Joinery (**ISBN-10:** 1510458131) available at amazon for £30

Uniform

Steel toe capped boots are required and are available to purchase from a number of local workwear and shoe shops at an approximate cost of £30. Please ensure you have these for the first day of term.

Safety gloves and any other PPE will be provided, as required.

Equipment

The college does provide a basic tool kit to use whilst in sessions. If you prefer to use your own kit, please see the list below for recommended tools. There will be a place to store your kit for the duration of your course.

All consumables i.e. screws, nails & glue will be provided along with use of power tools.

Please note that this is a basic introductory kit, progression onto a higher level course will require additional tools.

We recommend that if your place is conditional in achieving exam results that you do not purchase items until your place is confirmed.

Please be advised that we cannot accept responsibility for any missing tools that are not securely locked away in your tool box. If you lend out tools or leave them out, you will be responsible for any losses.

CSCS Cards

Students who have completed and achieved a level 1 Diploma in Carpentry and Joinery and are returning to undertake Level 2 will have an opportunity to sit the CSCS HS&E test for operatives. You will then be able to apply for a CSCS basic skills card. This will support the work experience on your study programme which may lead to progression to an apprenticeship.

The cost of the CSCS test and purchasing the CSCS card will be approximately £60.00.

Trips
