Resource Fee

Stationery

Equipment and Uniform

All students will require steel toe capped safety boots for the start of term which are available to purchase from a range of local suppliers at an approximate cost of £20.

All students are required to purchase a set of insulated screwdrivers (VDE 1000V), a pair of insulated side-cutters and have a tape measure. (£45). These are available from local wholesalers or some DIY stores. Course lecturers can provide further information and you will need to have these tools by week 3 of the course.

Safety gloves will be supplied as required.

We recommend that if your place is conditional in achieving exam results that you do not purchase items until your place is confirmed.
