

# **Travel and Tourism**

Welcome to Travel and Tourism at Wiltshire College and University Centre!

Please find below details of course related costs and items you may need to get, ready for the start of term.

### **Resource Fee**

You will need to pay your £25 non-refundable Resource Fee before coming to enrol. This can be done on the online shop <u>Wiltshire College Online Shop</u> You will need to bring a copy of your receipt to enrolment as proof of purchase. If you cannot pay online, please pay by card on enrolment day.

# **Stationery**

All students are required to provide their own personal stationery to include pads, pens and pencils, poly pockets and folders ready for the start of term. Course tutors will advise of any specific requirements at the start of term.

Students will need a scientific calculator if on a GCSE maths course as part of their study programme.

#### Uniform

All Travel & Tourism Students are required to wear the college Travel & Tourism uniform, which consists of a branded polo shirt and branded hoodie. Students are required to wear their uniform for both remote and in class sessions.

The uniform needs to be purchased directly from the supplier. Please can this be purchased within the first two weeks of the course.

### **Equipment**

All students will need to be suitably dressed for trips, visits and activities, and have any appropriate clothing, such as wet weather clothing.

#### **Books**

There is no mandatory requirement for learners to purchase text books for the Travel and Tourism courses, however there are various books which will help understand and support the curriculum. all which will be available through our LRC.

All students will be expected to attend the following trips during the year.

### Level 2 (example trips)

One day trip to Thorpe Park – approximately £25 per student One day trip to Longleat or similar – approximately £25 per students 2-3 day UK residential trip – approximately £250 per student

## Level 3 Year 1 (example trips)

One day trip to Thorpe Park – approximately £25 per student. One day trip to Longleat or similar – approximately £25 per student One day trip for Cabin Crew training – approximately £50 per student 3-4 days in Europe – approximately £300 per student.

## Level 3 Year 2 (example trips)

One day trip to Thorpe Park – approximately £25 per student.

One day trip to Longleat or similar – approximately £25 per student

One day trip for Cabin Crew training – approximately £50 per student

3-4 day trip on a city break and/or beach location depending on funds - £300 per student

Total Level 2 - £300 Total Level 3 - £400
